50-64 Players	5 Winners	1st: Package, 2nd: 45% of Remainder, 3rd: 30% of Remainder 4th: 15% of Remainder, 5th: 10% of Remainder

All amounts will be rounded to the nearest \$5 increment, with priority going to the higher position.

TOURNAMENT RULES

*Buy-In is Non-Refundable

*Standard Tournament Directors Association Rules apply.

*All Tournament seating will be done by random seat assignments. This will be done by drawing cards for seat assignment. An exception for disabled players will be made at the discretion of the Tournament Director.

*If two or more players go broke on the same deal, the player with the most chips to start the deal will finish in the higher position

*Tournament Director can have a chip count at his/her discretion at anytime

*Any Chips removed from the table for any reason other than switching tables at the Director order, will be disqualified

*Any player not following the Rules will be warned. If any Rules are still being Broken by the Player will eliminated from the Tournament and the Players Chips will be taken into the Dealers Tray

*All other House Poker Rules Apply

*The Hideaway reserves the right to change, alter or cancel this tournament at any time.

*Decision of Tournament Director is FINAL

*Procedures required for W2-G's will be followed for prizes in excess of \$5000

** Approximately \$2000 will be withheld at time of tournament for tax purposes.

Multiple flight procedures

If there are more than 44 players signed up before the 10:30 am deadline, the Tournament Director will split the tournament into two flights. If there are not 45 players, the tournament will play down to the final table to be played at the preannounced later date as previously advertised, and any alternates will be seated before the end of the third round.

The players will be randomly assigned to flights prior to the start of the first flight, with an equal number of players in each flight. (If there are an unequal number of players, the second flight will have the extra player.)

The Tournament Director will take an equal number of red and black playing cards with the total number of cards being the final number of tournament entries. The Tournament Director will then draw those cards starting with entry number one to determine flight status. Flight one will consist of all entrants with 'red' cards drawn, flight two will consist of all entrants with 'black' cards drawn. If there is an odd number of tournament entrants, the 'black' flight will have the extra player.

Once the flights are determined, if a Tournament Entrant opts out and receives a refund, late entrants will be taken in order of signup to replace the original Entrant. There will be no alternates seated once the flight starts.

Each flight will play down to 15 players, the time remaining in the round and the round number will be recorded, each player's chips will be 'bagged and tagged' with the player's name and chip count recorded on a separate piece of paper that is placed in the bag, as well as recorded on a master sheet.

Once the final three tables are determined, the players will return on a preannounced and advertised date. The tournament clock will be reset to the earliest group's remaining time, and play will continue as normal. Any player not returning on the later date will have their chips blinded out with antes posted.

10 Free seats for Daily Tournament Players

On the 10 Sunday evenings from November 29th through January 31st inclusive, the House will have the opportunity, but not the obligation, to add a \$300 seat to our Event being held on Saturday, February 6th.

If the winner of the Sunday Night Tournament finished at the final table of any Daily Tournament in the previous 7 calendar days, they will receive a House Added Entry to the event on February 6th.

If the winner of the Sunday evening tournament has either previously been awarded a seat into the Event, or did not finish at a final table in the previous 7 calendar days, then no Entry will be awarded.
